DERBY RULES

THIS DERBY IS FOR THE YOUTH

Due to problems and comments from prior derbies, we have enacted some rules for the fishing derby

1. Derby is for children 12 years of age and younger.
2. 4 fish limit. NO CULLING. You keep what you catch.
3. Adults may cast the line. Once the line is in the water, the youth **MUST** have control of the rod.
4. Adult may net the fish but the youth **MUST** reel it in. Adults may help hold the rod but the youth **MUST** be doing the reeling.
5. No spinners.
6. Largest fish will be determined by length. In the event of a tie, the weight will be the tie breaker.
7. Prizes will be awarded for the following (one for boy and one for girl)
Largest fish
First Palomino turned in at pavilion

First limit turned in at pavilion

First limit overall will receive the Angie

Stayer Award and have their name added to the plaque in the club house.

8. Anyone violating these rules will receive one warning. The second time, they will be asked to leave.

ALL RANGES CLOSED - Grounds are closed for maintenance or special Activities

There is also a second set of hooks at the bottom of the sign so that two different signs can be hung at the same time. For example: RIFLE RANGE CLOSED and PISTOL RANGE IN USE.

Hunter/ Trapper Education

If you wish to take the course on-line, the Game Commission makes available two online Hunter-Trapper Education courses for students who prefer to learn through an online format. A training certificate recognized throughout North America is awarded after passing a test at the end of either online course.

Online Hunter-Education: Available to anyone 11 years and older. Complete the online Pennsylvania Hunter-Trapper Education course opens In A New Window and print a temporary hunter education certificate (a permanent will be mailed). The cost to complete this course is \$34.95.

NRA Free Online Hunter Education Course: Available to anyone 11 years and older. Complete the online Pennsylvania Hunter-Trapper Education course Opens In A New Window to receive a hunter education certificate. Certification is only available for Pennsylvania residents. **Students will**

need a Pennsylvania Customer ID number to complete this course. Visit HuntFishPA to locate your existing Customer ID number or create a new one. You will be asked for this number at the end of the NRA online class, and it is required to receive your certificate.
