Nursery

The PA Fish and Boat Commission (PFBC) has been delaying the delivery of our trout this year due to the discovery of New Zealand Mudsnails at some of their nurseries. These very tiny snails are an invasive species and PFBC is working to minimize their spread. Some of the clubs are starting to receive their fish from the PFBC and our hope is that we will soon be getting ours.

Breakfast

Our current plans are to start our breakfast on January 14, 2023. However, due to the increase price of supplies, we will probably have to increase the price to \$12.00 per person. Hunter/ Trapper Education

We will be holding a hunter/trapper education course on March 18, 2024 at the club. Registration should be available around mid-January. To register, go to the game commission website, www.pgc.gov. Select EDUCATION and walk down through the selections to find our class.

If you wish to take the course on-line, the Game Commission makes available two online Hunter-Trapper Education courses for students who prefer to learn through an online format. A training certificate recognized throughout North America is awarded after passing a test at the end of either online course.

Online Hunter-Education: Available to anyone 11 years and older. Complete the online Pennsylvania Hunter-Trapper Education course opens In A New Window and print a temporary hunter education certificate (a permanent will be mailed) at the end of the course. There is a cost to complete this course.

NRA Free Online Hunter Education Course: Available to anyone 11 years and older. Complete the online Pennsylvania Hunter-Trapper Education course Opens In A New Window to receive a hunter education certificate. Certification is only available for Pennsylvania residents. Students will need a Pennsylvania Customer ID number to complete this course. Visit HuntFishPA to locate your existing Customer ID number or create a new one. You will be asked for this number at the end of the NRA online class, and it is required to receive your certificate.
