If you wish to take the course on-line, the Game Commission has made available two online Hunter-Trapper Education courses for students who prefer to learn through an online format. A training certificate recognized throughout North America is awarded after passing a test at the end of either online course.

Online Hunter-Education: Available to anyone 11 years and older. <u>Complete</u> the online Pennsylvania Hunter-Trapper Education courseOpens In A New <u>Window</u> and print a temporary hunter education certificate (a permanent will be mailed). The cost to complete this course is \$34.95.

NRA Free Online Hunter Education Course: Available to anyone 11 years and older. Complete the online Pennsylvania Hunter-Trapper Education course Opens In A New Window to receive a hunter education certificate. Certification is only available for Pennsylvania residents. Students will need a Pennsylvania Customer ID number to complete this course. Visit <u>HuntFishPA</u> to locate your existing Customer ID number or create a new one. You will be asked for this number at the end of the NRA online class, and it is required to receive your certificate.

Range Report

Please review the range rules below. If you see anyone who is not following the rules of the club or find someone using the ranges who are not members, please report it to the officers or contact us through our website.

- No loaded guns on premises unless ready to be fired on the firing line.
- Trap range to be used at regularly scheduled club events or with special permission given by the directors.
- 3. Trap range and/or rifle range will not be used when McKenzie range is in use.
- 4. McKenzie range will not be used when trap or rifle range is in use.
- 5. Trap range and rifle range cannot be used at the same time.

- 6. All guns should be cased or have actions open when not on firing line.
- 7. Only one person shooting from a shooting table at one time.
- 8. All shooters **MUST** wear hearing and eye protection.
- 9. All guns that are on the firing line must be put on gun rack with actions open before anyone proceeds to the target.
- 10. Range sign in parking lot must be displayed to show that shooting ranges are in use.
- 11. Shooting hours are: Monday through Saturday - 8:00 AM until one-half hour before sunset. Sunday - 12:00 Noon until one-half hour before sunset. Times will be determined by the PA Game Commission shooting hours table.
- 12. Only enter the rifle range building from the side entrance.
- 13. No alcoholic beverages or other illegal substances or people under the influence of these are allowed on the premises.
- 14. Shooting is limited to established backstops. No bottles, cans, etc. are permitted.
- 15. Metal targets are for full lead bullets only. Jacketed bullets will damage the targets and may cause injury to shooter or others.
- 16. Range behind club house is for HAND GUNS ONLY.

FAILURE TO ABIDE BY ANY OF THESE RULES MAY RESULT IN LOSS OF MEMBERSHIP.
